LOBSTERS, SAILING, AND MUSIC (3- & 4-NIGHT TRIPS)

Enjoy days of sailing, and evenings of relaxing conversation, music provided by the captains, or quiet reflection on your day and surroundings. Without a set itinerary, we'll let the winds, weather, and tides determine where we sail and where we anchor. Some of our favorite anchorages are in the harbors of fishing villages and small coastal communities, or in quiet coves off secluded islands. Enjoy going for an evening row, or even a sail, in one of our three small boats that we carry with us. Sometime during the trip, we will enjoy an all-you-can-eat lobster picnic on an uninhabited island's pristine beach. This trip is perfect for letting go of everyday stress or combining other activities during your East Coast vacation.

SCHOONER GAM ~ A GATHERING OF THE FLEET

Join in the celebration for incredible photo opportunities and a grand sight the likes of which is unseen anywhere else in the world! We sail to a picturesque anchorage with the windjammer fleet and tie up together for an evening of food, stories, music, and laughter. Walk from boat to boat seeing these traditional and historic vessels up close or take one of our small boats for a row around the rafted up fleet for a view of all the schooners that is unmatched!

LIGHTHOUSES AND SHORE TRIPS (5-NIGHT TRIPS)

Unplug from life and stress as we make our way along the picturesque Maine Coast. We will wander our way past coastal communities, fishing villages and uninhabited islands with the wind as our guide. Along the way we will observe many of the famed Maine Coast lighthouses—starting our venture passing between the Rockland breakwater light and the majestic Owl's Head light, we'll observe many more along our journey from the distinguished Mark Island light to the whimsical Gooserocks light. With a visit ashore to one of the coastal communities we'll take the opportunity to explore, stretch our legs and possibly do a little shopping. Our lobster bake will again take us ashore to one of the many uninhabited islands for us to explore, hike some trails, beach comb and enjoy the freshest lobster imaginable!

EXPLORE THE MAINE COAST (6-NIGHT TRIPS)

Sail away from civilization in search of adventure and relaxation. With six nights and no itinerary, we can choose distant destinations, less frequented islands and capitalize on the whims of the wind, exploring the rugged coast of Maine along the way. Visit picturesque fishing villages, sail through narrow passages that open up into grand bays of pristine waters cradled by mountains and enjoy lobsters on an uninhabited island beach! At night we'll anchor in remote coves and time-honored harbors. Enjoy rowing or sailing small boats for exploration or peaceful time for your thoughts.

GREAT SCHOONER RACE ~ A GATHERING OF THE FLEET

Join us as we set off from Rockland in search of fine sailing, a pristine island to explore enjoying an all-you-can-eat lobster bake, and beautiful sunsets. Later in the trip we'll meet up with a dozen other historic vessels for an evening at anchor together with the added entertainment of a fleet-wide small boat race. Schooner crews and guests alike utilize the small crafts carried aboard the vessels—varying from paddle boards to small sailing crafts—to enter in a race of good natured competition complete with themed costumes and much hilarity! Anticipation builds as the following morning we all weigh anchors and set sail together to compete in a Great Schooner Race, contesting speed and skill as we reach for the finish line where we will all celebrate throughout the evening together dockside.

PERSEID METEOR SHOWERS

*Join us as we sail through the days in search of the remote anchorages sheltered from lights. Enjoy late nights on deck participating in quiet conversations with all eyes turned to the sky as the Perseid Meteor Showers put on a show for us. Cheers and exclamations announce each meteor as it blazes across the sky! *Weather and sky conditions effect quality of view and sightings*

CAMDEN WINDJAMMER FESTIVAL ~ A GATHERING OF THE FLEET

Explore the Maine coast in search of the perfect lobster island before we head toward the beautiful town of Camden, where the mountains meet the sea. Join us the one time each year when we sail into Camden Harbor, reminiscent of the days when dozens of schooners lined the waterfront. Crowds from shore watch in envy as we sail in with the ship dressed in flags. Our arrival at the dock is celebrated by firing the ship's cannon. Head ashore and join the festivities! Visit artisanal Maine shops and craft vendors. Explore the scenic town and enjoy the beautiful parks and gardens. Cap off the day with a spirited talent show between the windjammers' crews.

WOODEN BOAT RENDEZ-VOUS ~ A GATHERING OF THE FLEET

The last get-together of the fleet for the season celebrating wooden boats. Prepare to be awed as the schooners of the fleet all come together in a parade of sail before anchoring in front of Wooden Boat Magazine's waterfront on scenic Eggemoggin Reach. Guests are welcome to go ashore and tour the Wooden Boat school and bookstore while exploring the beautiful grounds. How many lobsters can you eat? You're welcome to find out at the all-you-can-eat picnic on Lobster Island! Should the weather and conditions favor us, we may opt to tie up together as a fleet, providing the unforgettable opportunity to celebrate together as a "gam"!
